announce the competition for the**

### **PRIZE of the PONTIFICAL ACADEMIES 2018**

As foreseen by the Regulation of the Prize and in agreement with the Pontifical Council for Culture, the *Pontifical Academy of Theology* and the *Pontifical Academy of St. Thomas Aquinas* are organising the Competition for the Prize of the Pontifical Academies 2018 (the award is a sum of 20,000.00 Euros), to be assigned by the Holy Father during the annual Public Session of the Pontifical Academies.

The competition is open to young academics, not yet 40 years old, whose research and activity significantly contributes to the development of theological knowledge and the study of the thought of Thomas Aquinas within the horizon of Christian humanism.

The works proposed (in Italian, English, French or Spanish) should look at the theme “Eschatology and Eternal Life” for the area of research of the Pontifical Academy for Theology and to “The *Novissimi* in the Thomist Tradition” for the field of study of the Pontifical Academy of St. Thomas Aquinas.

Both unpublished works and those published within the last five years may be proposed.

Candidates should send their own works, via post, with the indication “*Premio delle Pontificie Accademie*” on the envelope to the Pontifical Council for Culture, *via della Conciliazione, 5 – 00193 Rome*, by May 12, 2018. The proposals should be accompanied by a *curriculum vitae* of the authors.
